The 6-pack of special ferns contains a variety of delightful ferns. Contrary to popular belief, ferns grow in a wide variety of habitats and most homes or business environments will have a spot in which these carefully selected species will thrive.

Or why not plant them in decorative pots or tubs? These can be moved as conditions and the seasons change, or even brought inside.

### Asplenium flaccidum – hanging spleenwort

Height: 0.6m; Spread: 0.2m



An epiphytic species growing on tree trunks, logs and rocks. Suitable for hanging baskets – slow-growing.





### Asplenium lamprophyllum

Height: 0.5m; Spread: 1m



Large clumps formed by a slow-creeping rhizome. Glossy foliage in heavy-shaded moist but free-draining conditions.





### Asplenium oblongifolium - shining spleenwort

Height: 1m; Spread: 1m



Lush green foliage. Prefers dry situations in semi-shade and good soil. Makes an excellent pot plant.

#### Blechnum discolor - crown fern

Height: 1m; Spread: 1m



Forms shuttlecock-shaped clumps with short trunks. Often sprouts off new plants. Easy to grow, but prefers moist soils. Found in high rainfall areas.

Grows well in large ceramic pots.





### Lastreopsis microsora subsp. pentangularis

Height: 0.4m; Spread: 0.6m



Creeping, slow-spreading fern. Bright green fronds. Easy to grow in sheltered shade.



## Marratia salicina - king fern, para

Height: 2.5m; Spread: 2.5m





Frost-tender, tropical fern. Requires shade and damp soil. Good pot plant. Slow-growing. Now renamed as Ptisana salicina as it is closely related to that tropical genus.





#### Pellaea falcata

Height: 0.4m; Spread: 0.4m



Drought-tolerant but grows better in moist free-draining soil. Slow-creeping habit.





#### Polystichum wawranum - shore shield fern

Height: 0.75m; Spread: 1m



A common coastal species growing on exposed rocks and along bush edges. Prefers rich soil. This recently renamed species was known as Polystichum richardii.
